CAMPER CANCELLATION AND SESSION CHANGE POLICY

- **AFTER MAY 4, 2012, BUT PRIOR TO THE START OF CAMP:**
 - Cancellation of an application will result in a \$500 processing fee.
 - Campers moving from a longer session to a shorter session will be charged a \$250 change-of-session fee.
 - Refund requests for cancellation and session change will not be given until the end of the 2012 summer season.
- **AFTER CAMP STARTS, NO REFUNDS ARE GIVEN FOR A CAMPER WHO LEAVES BEFORE THE END OF HIS/HER SESSION:**
 - Enrollment for the 4 or 7 week sessions indicates that the parent/guardian is financially responsible for entire tuition. If parents are in doubt about a camper remaining for the full 7 week session, the child should be enrolled only for 4 weeks (if space permits, such campers will be welcome to register for the remaining 3 weeks).

These policies are in effect for each camper and are not influenced by the number of other family members enrolled.

Exception to the above policy: A refund request due to a health emergency, documented by a licensed medical professional (noting that the child will be unable to attend camp).

CAMP POLICIES & TERMS OF ENROLLMENT

Please read carefully and review policies with your children.

ELIGIBILITY FOR ENROLLMENT: Eligible campers are boys and girls, 7-16 years old. Campers must meet maturity standards (health and social) deemed appropriate by Camp Shalom Owners and Directors. Disclosure of all medical and psychological treatments, past and present is required before a camper enrolls in camp. Failure to provide full disclosure is grounds for cancellation of the application or immediate dismissal without refund. Campers are required to complete Camp Shalom's health form and submit proof of health insurance.

TELEPHONE POLICY: Each session campers will have a designated calling day and time (twice during 1st session and once during 2nd session). There will be NO additional calls allowed to/from campers during their camping period. FAX transmissions are reserved for business use only. Please use letters and one-way e-mail for correspondence. E-mail letters (2 max per week) should include the camper's name and bunk in the subject. Any camper who celebrates a birthday on camp will be allowed to receive a phone call (please refer to the "Birthday" form).

EARLY DEPARTURES AND DISMISSALS: There are no deductions from the tuition for a Camper arriving late or leaving early. Camp Shalom reserves the right to dismiss, without refund, any camper whose influence is negative for the camp. Illegal acts such as possession and/or consumption of illegal substances or alcoholic beverages, abusing prescription drugs, gambling, etc... are prohibited. Campers must turn in all medications to the Health Center. Suspensions and/or violations of these prohibitions as well as any other illegal acts constitute grounds for dismissal without refund. Once a camper is enrolled for a 4 or 7 week session, he or she is expected to remain for the full time, and no reduction from the fee will be granted for any interruption of the session.

VISITORS WEEKEND FOR FULL SESSION CAMPERS ONLY: Visitors weekend will begin on the last day of first session and end on the first day of 2nd session. Campers will be permitted to leave camp during the Visitor's Weekend with their parents and/or adult friends or relatives (only with written permission from parents or guardian). Full Session campers should be picked up and returned to camp during the above stated times (further details will be given prior to camp). Lunch will be served on opening day of 2nd Session for all 7 week campers and their families.

OFF-CAMP TRIP FUND:

Each session we take 1 full day trip to an Orlando theme park and 2 half-day trips (1 during 2nd session). Payment for all off-camp trips is condensed into one fee- \$175 for 1st Session, \$155 for 2nd Session and \$330 for 7 week campers. Campers will receive a small amount of spending money for each half day trip and \$35 spending money for the Orlando trip.

CANTEEN FUND:

The Canteen Fee includes 2 camp shirts and snacks and drinks at the "Canteen."

- Full Session (7 wks)- \$100
- 1st Session- \$60
- 2nd Session- \$50
- CIT (7 wks)- \$150

TIPPING: Camp Shalom does not endorse tipping; however, should you choose to tip your child's counselors we will provide a staff address list. **Please note that CIT's will be able to accept tips and we encourage parents to participate in this practice.** A typical CIT's tip from a camper would be \$5 per week.

PACKING: For your convenience, we will provide you with a packing list. Additionally, we strongly encourage all campers to use large duffel bags, without wheels. We advise campers using our bus transportation to avoid bringing footlockers/trunks or plastic drawers. Camp Shalom is not responsible for any items sent to laundry, for luggage lost in shipment to/from Camp or while at camp, for clothing or equipment lost in Camp or on trips. Do not send expensive clothing/items to Camp!

VALUABLES: Camp is responsible only for valuables (including money, passports and tickets) checked in at the office. While Camp Shalom does permit electronic items such as iPods, Ipod Touch, Nintendo DS' and Gameboys, etc..., Camp in no way will be held liable for any lost, broken or stolen items. **DO NOT BRING** internet-connectable electronic games or other internet connectable devices (iPod touch is okay).

PACKAGES: Camp Shalom prohibits contraband items from being brought or sent into Camp. Please understand that any packages or luggage may be opened by Camp Shalom Staff, and should it contain weapons, ammunition, alcohol, illicit drugs, pornography, tobacco products, fireworks, **food, candy or gum**, they will be confiscated and disposed of. Possession of illegal items is grounds for camper dismissal.

CELL PHONES: Camp Shalom has a strict ON-CAMP NO CELL PHONE Policy. It is extremely important that your child does not keep a cell phone in the cabin. If your child brings a cell phone to camp, you must check it in with the office upon arrival. Your child's cell phone should be clearly labeled and fully charged. Cell phones checked in with the camp office will be given back to the camper on the day of the Orlando Trip and checked back into the office at the end of the day. At no point is the camp responsible for your child's cell phone.
